1) Types

There are two types of BBQ's, gas and charcoal. Charcoal BBQ's are renowned for the traditional, smoky flavour they produce. Whereas, gas BBQ's are convenient to use and also produce great flavour.

We cater for all your needs with our charcoal and gas BBQ's and to help you decide which is right for you, this guide firstly looks at the different types of BBQ's so you can directly compare them.



2) Gas BBQ's

Gas BBQ's are becoming increasingly popular due to their efficiency and convenience. We offer some fantastic small to large BBQ's which provide you with a great cooking experience.

Convenient Cooking

Gas models are the most efficient as they take no time at all to heat up and start cooking your food. If you are looking for a convenient outdoor cooking experience, a gas BBQ is the right choice.

You also have more control over the temperature on a gas BBQ than you do on a charcoal one. A number of our gas BBQ's come with a heat indicator which takes the guesswork out of monitoring the cooking temperature and displays them in C and F.

Side Burners

Some models have side burners which make it possible to cook different foods easily and separately.

Low Maintenance

Unlike charcoal BBQ's, there's no ash to dispose of and they require little cleaning. We also included a propane hose and regulator with our gas BBQ's.



3) Charcoal BBQ's

When you think of a BBQ, it's probably a more traditional type that springs to mind. We offer a fantastic range to choose from and here's why they're still so popular.

Authentic Flavour

Charcoal BBQ's generate an even cooking temperature and mouth-watering, smoky flavour. These types of BBQ are generally cheaper than gas-powered ones but do take around 30-45 minutes after lighting, before you can use them.

4) Grills and cooking area size

It's important to consider how many people you'll be cooking for and therefore the size of the cooking area you will need.

How many people are you cooking for?

If you need a BBQ for yourself and another person, you'll only need a small BBQ. Medium sized BBQ's will cook for 2-4 people. For a large family or dinner guests, you'll need a large BBQ and for 8 or more people, you should opt for an extra large BBQ.

Material for BBQ grills:

- **Porcelain Coated Grills:** Easy to clean and don't rust. They create a smoky flavour when hot juices and fats drop down from the grill.
- **Cast Iron Grills:** Hold heat extremely well. Simply wipe the grill with cooking oil before and after use to help prevent rust.
- **Stainless Steel Grill:** Easy to clean, more durable than chrome-plated grills.
- **Chrome-plated Grills:** Looks good but needs cleaning thoroughly after use.



5) More BBQ Features

There's nothing better than a barbeque on a warm summer's day. If you're looking for a basic BBQ or a high-quality BBQ with a range of features, we have all you need for a truly enjoyable cooking experience.

Lids and Hoods

Hooded BBQ's are a great feature as you can use your BBQ to roast as well as grill food. When the lid is closed, it deflects the heat and smoke more evenly around the food. 3+ burner models are best for roasting as you can turn off the middle burner to avoid burning.

Griddles

Some models come with a griddle as well as a grill. These are great for cooking foods which may otherwise fall through the grill, like fried eggs or onions.

Accessories

Keep your BBQ protected from the weather with a BBQ cover. We offer PVC or Deluxe PE covers which are specifically designed to fit each BBQ. We also provide rotisseries, grills and regulators.

Outback Half Drum

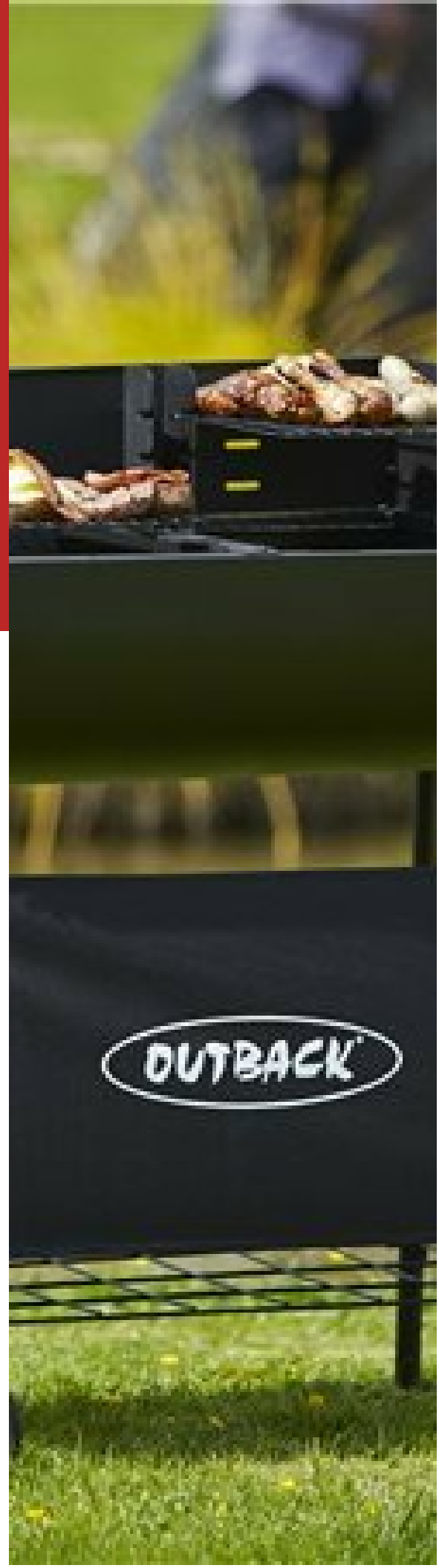
The Outback Half Drum has a wire base for handy storage, two adjustable cooking grills and a folding side table. The black finish looks stylish and modern.
